**THE COURT ORDERS AND DIRECTS THAT:**

1. Pursuant to s. 439A(6) of the *Corporations Act 2001* (Cth) ('Act'), the period within which the Applicants must convene the second meeting of creditors as fixed by s. 439A(5) of the Act be extended up to and including 12 August 2020.
2. Pursuant to s. 447A(1) of the Act, the second meeting of creditors required by s. 439A of the Act may be held at any time during or within 5 business days after the end of the convening period pursuant to Order 1, above, in spite of the provisions of s. 439A(2) of the Act.



3. The costs and expenses of the Originating Process filed by the Applicants in this proceeding be costs and expenses of the external administration of Glass Recovery Services Pty Limited (Administrators Appointed) ('GRS').
4. The contents of the affidavits sworn by Jason Glenn Stone on 5 February 2020 and 7 February 2020 and the affidavit by Glenn Jeffrey Franklin sworn 10 February 2020 together with their exhibits are kept confidential.
5. Any person claiming to be interested, including any creditor of GRS may make any application to vary or discharge any of these Orders upon 48 hours written notice to the Applicants.
6. By 5:00pm on 18 February 2020, the Applicants are to cause notice of these Orders to be provided:
  - a. by placing a copy of the Orders on the website maintained by the firm PKF at <www.pkf.com.au>; and
  - b. by email sent to all creditors who have provided the Applicants with an email address by circular notice.
7. By 5:00pm on 18 February 2020 the Applicants are to cause notice of these Orders by mail to ASIC and to all other creditors for whom the Applicants have only a mailing address by circular notice.
8. Liberty to apply.
